Please follow these guidelines in order to submit a contribution to the blog:

Content: You are invited to share and celebrate your personal explorations of the process of “human metamorphosis” – what it is to undertake the journey to awaken to your unique vision and mission, live in service of something greater than the Self, and deepen your connection to the human and other-than-human community of beings. Consider beauty and wonder of change, as well as the challenges associated with changing from within. Note: Ideally, your contribution will have been inspired by a Transformational Counseling session or workshop.

Format: Poetry, photographs, scanned artwork, and essays (in combination or alone) are all welcomed. Please limit poetry and essays to 1000 words. Book reviews relevant to Transformational Counseling's mission will also be accepted. Please limit these to 500 words.
